## TB07-002: UPGRADE PROCEDURES FOR NAVIGATOR 7.2R1 AND RIP MANAGER 3.3

The purpose of this bulletin is to outline specific procedures necessary when upgrading Navigator 7.X and RIP Manager 3.X users to GPS Build 3305 (Navigator 7.2r1 and RIP Manager 3.3). Depending on the configuration, certain precautions may be necessary for all the data and setups to migrate properly. Each scenario is outlined below and strict attention should be paid to each step.

### Upgrading ONLY the RIP Manager Software

If the upgrade consists only of RIP Manager 3.2 to RIP Manager 3.3, simply load the new RIP Manager software over (in the same directory) the previous version. NOTE: it is always a good idea to back up the RM database files (.jobs, .actions, .wf) found in the RIP Manager root directory before beginning the upgrade. After installation of the new version, copy these files back to their proper directory.

### Upgrading the Navigator RIP and RIP Manager Together (Navigator GPS)

To upgrade from an earlier version of Navigator GPS follow the steps below:

1. Make a note of the plug-ins being used by the RIP. These will be updated as well.
2. Insert the first CD and click the button labeled, "*Navigator GPS.*" When the *Destination Folder* screen appears, install the new version of GPS in a DIFFERENT directory from the current version.

The installation software will automatically find the old GPS or RIP directory AND the old GPS or RIP start menu folder and list these as the default choices. ***Manually change these to Navigator 7.2r1.***

3. After installation completes, insert Disc 2 and follow the prompts to load the necessary plug-ins noted in step 1.
4. Upon completion, restart the computer and then start the 7.2r1 RIP. This is necessary to establish "first run" files used by the Migrate Utility. Shut down the RIP.

5. Launch the Migrate utility found in the *Utilities Folder* of the new 7.2r1 RIP.
6. Copy the RIP Manager database files (.jobs .actions .wf) from the old RIP Manager directory to the same location in the new RIP Manager directory.

Start the new system and verify that all plug-ins, workflows and settings have migrated properly.
